Why the correct answer is right — and why each wrong option is incorrect.

1. Why does Anna like the colour blue?

✓ B — Because it is calm and beautiful. The passage states that Anna likes blue because it is calm and beautiful.

✗ A — Because it is loud and bright. The passage does not describe blue as loud and bright.

✗ C — Because it is her brother's favorite. Anna's brother likes red, not blue.

✗ D — Because it is her friend's favorite. Anna's friend Lisa likes pink, not blue.

2. What does Tom have that is red?

✓ C — A red t-shirt and shoes. The passage states that Tom has a red t-shirt and red shoes.

✗ A — A red dress and shoes. Tom does not have a red dress.

✗ B — A red hat and socks. The passage does not mention Tom having a red hat and socks.

✗ D — A red coat and scarf. Tom does not have a red coat and scarf.

3. What day does Anna wear her blue dress?

✓ B — Sunday The passage states that Anna wears her blue dress every Sunday.

✗ A — Monday The passage does not mention Anna wearing her dress on Monday.

✗ C — Friday Friday is when Tom wears his red clothes, not Anna.

4. What do Anna, Tom, and Lisa enjoy doing together?

✓ C — Talking about their favorite clothes and colors The passage states they talk about their favorite clothes and colors every week.

✗ A — Playing games The passage does not mention playing games.

✗ B — Cooking together The passage does not mention cooking together.

✗ D — Watching movies The passage does not mention watching movies.

5. What is the main idea of the passage?

✓ C — Anna and her friends enjoy sharing their favorite colors and clothes.

The main idea is about Anna and her friends talking about their favorite colors and clothes.

✗ A — Anna and her friends have a lot of clothes.

The passage focuses more on sharing colors, not having a lot of clothes.

✗ B — Anna and her family like to shop every week.

Shopping is not mentioned in the passage.

✗ D — Anna's favorite color is blue because it is calm.

While true, it is a detail, not the main idea.
