✗ C — Cooking There is no mention of the sister cooking.

✗ D — Painting Painting is not mentioned as the sister's activity.

### 2. Why is family time important to them?

✓ A — They have fun playing games The passage mentions they have fun playing games during family time.

✗ B — They like to watch TV Watching TV is not mentioned in the passage.

✗ C — They enjoy eating dinner together Eating dinner is not specified as part of their family time.

✗ D — They need to do homework Homework is not discussed in the context of family time.

### 3. Where does the father work?
